The Travel & Tourism Development Index (TTDI) is a direct evolution of the Travel & Tourism Competitiveness Index (TTCI)

Published biennially for the past 15 years

117 Countries

5 Subindexes, 17 pillars and 112 individual indicators

Public sector authorities (15 relevant ministries)

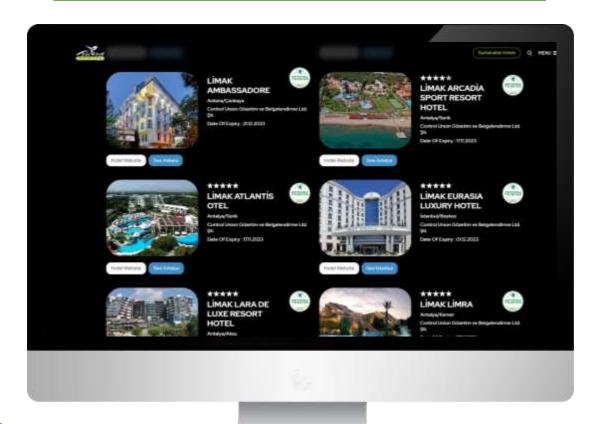

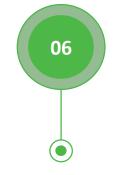
