MWG Environmental Sustainability Strategy



MWG sustainability targets towards near-term climate goals

	100% of our electricity consumption generated from renewable sources through on-site solar, RECs ¹ and/or vPPAs ² by 2030
	Potable water use intensity for SZG, NS and RW reduced by 25% from 2020 baseline by 2030 (target: 0.21m3/guest)
	100% of our internal fleet comprise either electric vehicles or vehicles with lower carbon emission fuel by 2030
	60% of our waste diverted from incineration by 2030
	100% of palm oil and its derivatives used in all end-products from certified sustainable sources* by 2025 <small>*Physically sourced RSPO³ certified or offset with Independent Small Holder RSPO³ credits</small>
	100% of Mandai-produced paper-based products are FSC ⁴ -certified or 100% recycled by 2025
	All guest-facing single-use fossil-based plastics eliminated-by 2023
	2.7 hectares of degraded land in the Buffers, Set-backs and Retained Forest are restored and enhanced by 2030
