This is the Report of Change on the Accreditation Manual for Certification of Accommodation/Hotel & Tour Operator, version 3.1.

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1. Introduction

This report gives an overview of the change on the revision of the Accreditation Manual for Certification of Accommodation/Hotel & Tour Operators version 3.1. As GSTC ends the Accreditation services through third-party organizations and provides Accreditation services directly, the revision has been made accordingly. Additionally, this revision does not include any newly added sections, clauses, or changes to the requirements, and only focuses on updating terminology. The approval date is October 1, 2023, and It will be effective from October 13, 2023.

2. Methodology

The methodology in this report is through a comprehensive review within the GSTC Accreditation Secretariat and Assurance Director.

3. Accreditation Manual Revision from 3.0 to 3.1

As GSTC directly conducts accreditation, related expressions have been revised. The following tables summarize these changes by section and type. Most of the modifications involve specifying GSTC as the entity responsible for the accreditation service.

By promoting sustainable and responsible practices in the tourism industry, GSTC continues to play a vital role in advancing global sustainable tourism standards.
